Ashby announces start of Billboard Campaign highlighting Congresswoman Cori Bush's support for Defunding Police

St. Louis, MO, June 12, 2024 — Blake Ashby, the Better Party's candidate for MO's 1st Congressional District, announced the start of a billboard campaign highlighting Rep. Cori Bush's extremism. The first billboard will call out Bush's continued support for defunding the Police.

"My wife and I, as part of the Ferguson Neighborhood Policing Committee, surveyed hundreds of Ferguson residents in the area where Michael Brown was killed. Overwhelmingly, Fergusons residents of all races didn't want less policing – they wanted better policing."
